TOURNAMENT RULES

- The Gungahlin Lakes SMITHS CRISPS Mens' Amateur is OPEN to MALE golfers with a valid and current AGU Handicap from a **recognised** Golf Club affiliated with a State or Overseas Association. The maximum handicap for this event is 27, players with a club handicap higher than 27, will be required to play in the tournament off 27.
- Starting times will be from 0730-1200. All play will commence from the 1st tee. Every effort will be made to place participants in their preferred starting times. Preferred starting times will be allocated in order of Entry Form receipt.
- On Day Two, the top six (6) players in each Division (Gross scores) from Round 1, may be required to play in a seeded draw towards the end of the field (1030-1115). These tee times will be displayed as soon as possible after completion of play on Day One.
- Entries will close on Friday 17 August 2007 at 6:00pm, or when a capacity field is reached.
- Handicap grades will be determined by the GLGC Match Committee after receipt of entries.
- The use of motorised buggies/other ride-on vehicles is prohibited, unless authorised by the GLGC Match Committee.
- The Entry Form will not be accepted unless accompanied by the Entry Fee.
- Late entries will be accepted if vacancies exist and will be subject to payment of a \$10.00 Late Entry Fee.
- Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf, as recognised by the AGU, and the GLGC Local Rules. Penalties for slow play will be applied.
- The GLGC Match Committee shall have the power to vary any conditions and to determine any dispute or question arising as to the disqualification of any entrant and may, at its absolute discretion at any time and without assigning reason therefore, refuse entry or declare any entrant ineligible to compete.
- Players must report to the starter ready to tee off at least twenty minutes prior to their designated Tee Time. Failure to do so may result in disqualification or the addition of penalty strokes (2) to a player's card.
- In the event of a tie in the Gross Competitions, the winner will be decided by a playoff. Players not present to contest the play-off will be declared ineligible for the play-off. All Nett events will be decided by count back as prescribed by the AGU in the current AGU Handbook.
- Unless full **GolfLink Number** is provided a handicap card must be available for perusal by the GLGC Match Committee.
- Players and their caddies **MUST** comply with the Dress requirements of the Gungahlin Lakes Golf Club. Non-compliance could see the player not allowed to start or asked to leave the course.
- All Presentations will be made approx 40 minutes after the completion of play on Day Two.
- Metal spikes are not permitted.
- No electronic or laser distance measuring devices are permitted.
- Cancellation and refunds: No refunds will be made for any cancellation received less than 7 days prior to the event, except cancellations on medical grounds or incapacity will be given consideration. If a refund is to be made then a cancellation fee of \$5 dollars will be retained.
