2022 Yowani Men's Open (Gross) and Cup (Handicap)

Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 May 2022

Terms of the Competition

1. The controlling Committee is the men's Golf Match Committee of Yowani Country Club and the Committee will have the power to vary the terms of the competition and to decide any dispute or question.
2. Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of Yowani Country Club. **Pace of Play** conditions apply, as per Rule 9 of the current Golf NSW Hard Card. Any special Local Rules, including Pace of Play, will be available at the starter's desk on the first day of play.
3. The event is an amateur competition. All competitors in the event must have a current GA Handicap. A maximum daily handicap limit of 36 applies for this event. First round handicaps will remain the same for determining Championship results. Daily prizes will be decided on daily handicaps.
4. Numbers are limited to 160. If a ballot is required, priority will be given to entrants with handicaps lower than the Vardon threshold of 4.4 GA, then time of receipt of entry.
5. Entries will ONLY be received online via the TryBooking site provided. A waiting list will be maintained for entry forms received after the limit is reached. There will be no refunds provided for cancellations advised after the draw has been completed unless a medical certificate or COVID notice is presented.
6. The draw – 2-tee start – is intended to be available by 4pm Mon 23 May 2022 with full conditions for the Hole-in-One prize, at www.yowani.com.au/golf
 - a) The draw will be emailed to players who provide an email address.
 - b) The same starting time will generally apply to both days with the starting tee swapped. Requests to swap am/pm times will be considered.
 - c) Once entries have closed and if places are available, single day players may be accepted, on payment of half the relevant total entry fee.
7. Players should be ready to commence play 15 minutes before their scheduled tee time. Daily event registration is required in the Pro Shop (starters desk).
8. Carts may be used, subject to availability. Book directly with the Pro Shop – **02 6228 9739**.
9. For the Yowani Cup, grades A, B, and C will be split into approximately equally sized fields, based on the starting daily handicaps of accepted entries.
10. Each player is eligible to win only one day prize, plus one overall (two day) prize. Any single day players will be eligible for day prizes only. Prizes may be in the form of a Yowani credit (for Yowani members) or EFTPOS card. The Yowani Cup trophy winner MUST have recorded at least 8 rounds in Golf Link in the past 12 months.
11. If, at the completion of 36 holes, a tie exists in the overall Open event, a sudden death playoff will be held from the 1st hole. To be eligible to win the overall Yowani Open, a player must make himself available to participate in the play off, if one is required. **All other events shall be decided by the GA count back rules.**
